



## Policies for Vendors

Below is the list of Vendor modifications that the Oberlin Farmers Market will require of vendors as long as COVID-19 poses the level of risk we are currently experiencing. These guidelines are effective beginning May 2021 and will remain in effect for 2021 season until we learn that they are considered unnecessary by the CDC, state and local health departments.

- If you are sick, stay home.
- Limit the sale of food to whole, uncut produce and packaged food items. No on-site food preparation will be allowed.
- All ready-to-eat foods must be pre-packaged before arriving at market.
- No sampling of any food is permitted.
- Maintain a 6' social distance between yourself, vendors, and other customers.
- Vendors, employees, and volunteers must wear cloth face covering.
- Clean your hands frequently and sanitize your stands regularly.
